Need help with bikini wax!



- There are four main styles of bikini wax:
 - Hollywood (completely bare)
 - Brazilian (with a landing strip)
- G-string/Thong/French wax (extended bikini)
 - Basic Bikini (clean sides)

Bikini Line Wax



Hair is removed around the bikini line, so hair doesn't stick out when you're in a swimsuit or underwear.

Full Bikini Wax




Similar to a bikini line wax, but you have more hair removed from the top and sides.

French Wax



All hair is removed from the pubic area except for a small strip of hair.

Hollywood Wax



All hair is removed from the pubic area, including around the upper thighs, labia, and butt.

A Bikini wax removes all of the hair that would be visible when wearing underwear or a bathing suit bottom. Depending on the style you choose, bikini waxes can include just cleaning up the sides or going further inward to eliminate most of the hair surrounding your lady bits. A Brazilian wax leaves (nearly) the entire region bare and involves removing hair from the front, back and sides

Preparing for your waxing

- It might be a bit painful, if your threshold is low, take a pain killer 30 minutes prior to the appointment.
 - Don't forget to take a shower and cleanse the area well before coming to the salon.
- Exfoliate your skin the day you have your appointment, this ensures your wax goes on evenly. It will also allow the hair to get uprooted with ease.
 - Avoid five days before and after your periods

After care

Wear loose cotton clothes

Do not exercise or take a hot shower or bath within 24 hours

Avoid exposure to UV rays

Use Ingrown spray solution or cream.
